## A Warm Welcome to All!

*This morning we are delighted to welcome Rev. Young-Mee Park, District Superintendent of Dekalb District, to our service! Rev. Park is a second career clergywoman with the experience of living, working, and going to school and church on three different continents—Asia, Europe, and America. Rev. Park was born and raised in Korea, where most of her family members still reside. She went to France pursuing further education. After obtaining a BA, an MA and a PhD in Linguistics she returned to Korea and taught at both undergraduate and graduate levels. She then came to the United States in 2000 and went to Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary because she had so many questions about the life of faith. Her seminary study was such a liberating and empowering experience that she decided to pursue ordination and enter the ministry.*

*Upon graduation from Garrett in 2003, Rev. Park was appointed to First UMC of Dixon as an associate pastor and in 2005 to First UMC of Oak Park, where she arrived as the first female and the first non-Caucasian pastor in the church's 135 years of history. After eight years of fruitful ministry strengthening its mission and revitalizing its congregation, Rev. Park returned to DeKalb District a year ago and began a new position as the District Superintendent. Rev. Park is a passionate learner and appreciates any opportunity to grow as a whole person created in God's image. She firmly believes in the United Methodist Women's vision of providing "educational experiences that lead to personal change in order to transform the world."*

*Rev. Park is married to Rev. Dr. Sang Hyeon Yoo and they have two children, Ihwan and Eunhwan.*
