UMCL Financial Update 2016 and 2017

2016 Review

In 2016 our congregation continued to faithfully and generously give their time, talents, and treasure. There are too many wonderful missions and ministries to name. In terms of finances, we received 98% of the money that was committed, with our total contributions from offerings and the Capital Campaign totaling \$1.2 million. We thank you for your faithful and generous giving.

In terms of our budget, as we entered 2016, we were highly optimistic, and made aggressive projections of growth in contributions. However, these projections proved to be overly optimistic and, in spite of significant belt tightening by our ministry areas, we ended the year with a deficit of \$117,000. Because our church is very strong financially with good reserves (similar to a savings account), we were able to absorb this shortfall in 2016.

Our 2017 Challenge

We sense a wonderful spirit of energy and excitement as we enter 2017. We have amazing ministries, a great staff, excellent facilities and a bright future. However, we are once again challenged by our Operating budget. We want to continue to grow our ministries but, at the same time, we don't want to tap into our reserves if at all possible. Currently, our projected contributions to the Operating budget do not cover our projected expenses which would leave us with another significant shortfall if we don't make some adjustments.

Budget Task Force

Given this situation, the Administrative Council at its January meeting commissioned a Budget Task Force to work on this challenge. The Task Force is made of leaders from within the church including Mike Conway, Mike Foley, Kevin Garren, Jayden Montgomery, Dave Natzke, Jill Natzke, Jesse Nixon, Jim Stewart, Candice Tonon, Pastor Jamie and Pastor Steve.

This excellent and dedicated team is carefully and creatively working on the 2017 Budget, considering ways to increase income as well as reduce expenses, in order to have a more closely balanced budget for this year and beyond. The Budget Task Force will present its recommendations and a 2017 Budget proposal to the Administrative Council at its meeting on Saturday, March 4. All are welcome to attend and learn more about our plans.

We ask that you continue to hold the church in your prayers as we move faithfully toward the future. As Mike Foley stated in worship on Sunday, February 6, this financial situation is not a crisis but a bump in the road that we trust God will help us to smooth out. If you have not yet made a financial commitment to the church Operating Budget for 2017, we would love to hear from you. Financial Commitment forms are in the Community Room on the Welcome Table near the office window. We will also be providing some creative giving opportunities in the months ahead that are part of our Budget plan.

Thank you for your faithfulness and commitment to the church as we work together to exhibit sound financial stewardship while supporting our mission to glorify God by lifting up Christ, using our gifts and ministering to all!

Ash Wednesday Service

Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on the Saturday before Easter. Lent comes from the Anglo-Saxon word lencten, which means "spring." This season is a preparation for celebrating Easter. Historically, Lent began as a period of fasting and preparation for baptism by those who were becoming Christians and later it became a time of self-examination and penance by all Christians.

It is a season when we remember Christ's forty days of fasting and prayer in the wilderness when he faced and overcame the challenges and temptations of the devil. The primary focus is on rededicating ourselves to the Christian life as a preparation for the Easter season to come. It is a time for introspection, for slowing down, for centering in on God.

We invite you to begin the Lenten journey with us at an Ash Wednesday Service of meditation, music and prayer on March 1 at 7:30 pm. This service will provide a quiet and sacred space for you to reflect on your life and listen for the voice of God as you seek to draw closer to God and others.

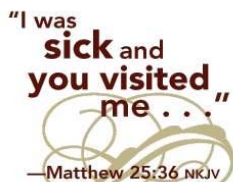
GREEN LIVING FAIR
